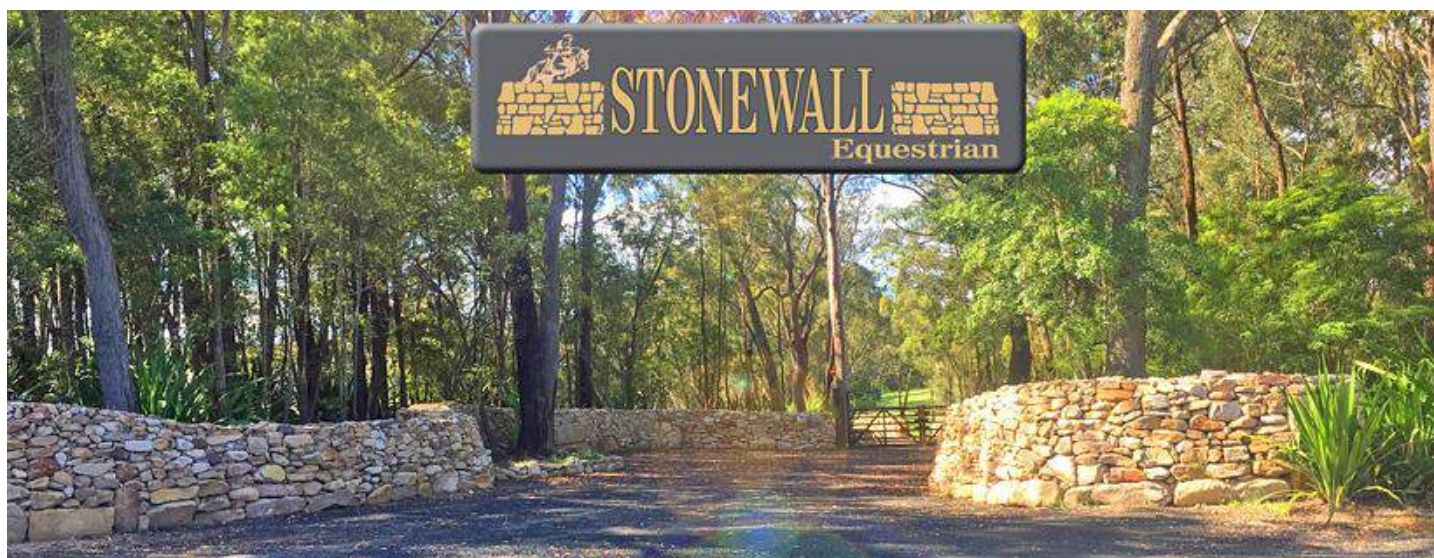

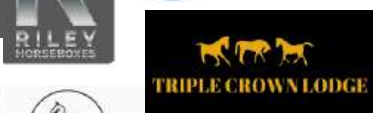

1 This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations. Including the following:

- a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
- b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
- c. EA Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
- d. FEI & EA World Cup Rules, FEI 1* Rules, FEI Rules for Youth Olympic Qualifier.
- e. EA Age rules including Junior & Young Rider
- f. EA Amateur rules

2 Australian Helmet Standards will apply. All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted, including presentations
All Helmets must be tagged

3 All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on the online platform. A guardian entering for a minor agrees to those terms for the minor. If your entries are done by a third person, then it will be deemed that you have accepted the conditions of entry by your participation in the show.

4 After any fall anywhere at Stonewall, the rider must be cleared by the Medical Services Provider BEFORE re-mounting. AGGRESSIVE OR RUDE BEHAVIOUR TO THE PARAMEDICS will result in elimination from the whole show.

5 The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program, conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.

6 The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.

7 The OC reserves the right to swab horses as per EA & FEI rules & regulations

8 All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.

9 Scooters – are allowed at Stonewall but riders must wear their riding helmet or an approved cycle helmet.

10 All riders and owners must be financial members of EA. EA memberships & registrations will be verified.

11 GST– is included in all fees and charges and Prizemoney

12 Showjumping Prizemoney – All showjumping prizemoney will be paid via the online entry platform. Please ensure your banking details are up to date or your prizemoney cannot be paid.

13 Entry Changes

- a. Entry changes can be made at the administration office or by emailing entries@stonewallequestrian.com.au.
- b. Will incur a \$5 fee per class.
- c. Rider names must be correct at time of competition.
- d. If an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$5 per incorrect entry will be incurred. **This includes incorrect horse/rider names/combinations.**

14 Refunds

- a. Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$10 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically
- b. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
- c. NO refunds will be issued once the event has commenced.

15 Presentation of Prizes – Prizes for each class will be awarded immediately following the event. Presentations in the Grand Prix Arena will be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets. Presentations in other rings will be at the direction of the OC.

- a. Anyone who does not present at presentation may forfeit all prize money. If a rider is not available for presentations due to extenuating circumstances, a substitute must be found.
- b. Riders with stallions or a difficult horse that are placed in a class should substitute this horse for another horse for the presentation

16 Dogs & Prams

- a. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
- b. Dogs and prams are not allowed in the warm up or competition area
- c. No animals in the shower or toilet blocks. Dog tie-ups are available on the verandah.

17 Number of Showjumping Starts:

- a. A horse can have two starts in consecutive Classes unless otherwise stated on the program
- b. Where there are concurrent classes (as in a/b sections), a rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class but not on the same horse
- c. No HC entries allowed. Only 1 round per horse per class

18 Maximum number of showjumping starts per rider – Maximum of 4 starts per rider per class.

19 Draw Order for Showjumping – Grand Prix Arena will run to draw order without exception. Competitors who miss their draw will forfeit the class. Future Stars arena will run to draw order with the exception of a rider being in the Grand Prix Arena. If riding out of order you **MUST** ride the horse that was your first ride on the draw.

Complaints And Protests

All complaints or protests in any way related to the event, whether valid or not, will not be considered by the Organising Committee unless they are presented in legible writing, accompanied by \$50 and duly signed by a single clearly identified person. Protests must be received within 15 minutes of the completion of the class. When a letter is being presented on behalf of a group, it is that group's responsibility to nominate a person to sign it on their behalf. Whether any letter of complaint or protest is acted upon or not is at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

THE COMMITTEE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO THE EVENT TO ANY PERSON AND ALSO REFUSE TO ACCEPT ANY ENTRIES INTO THE COMPET

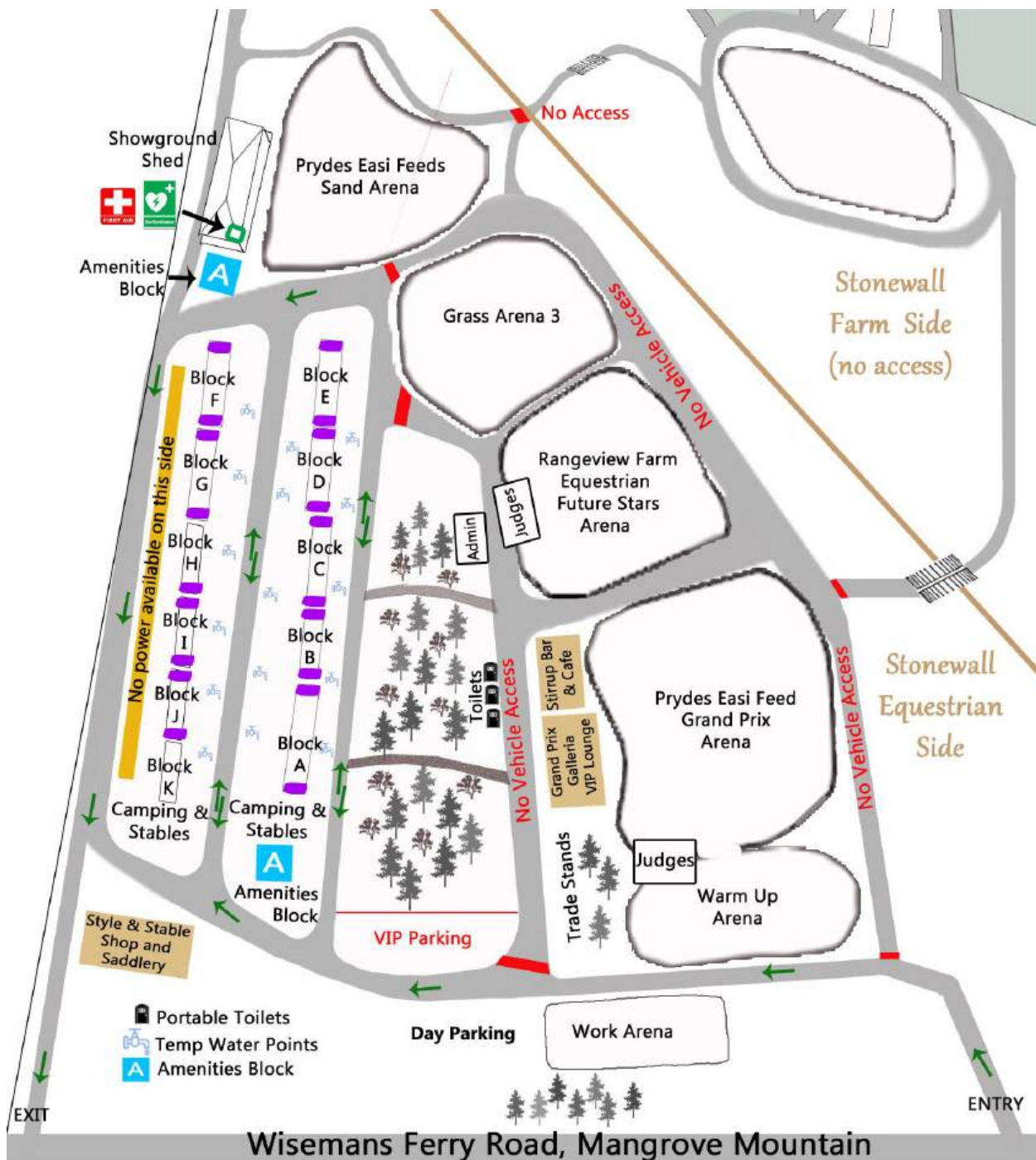

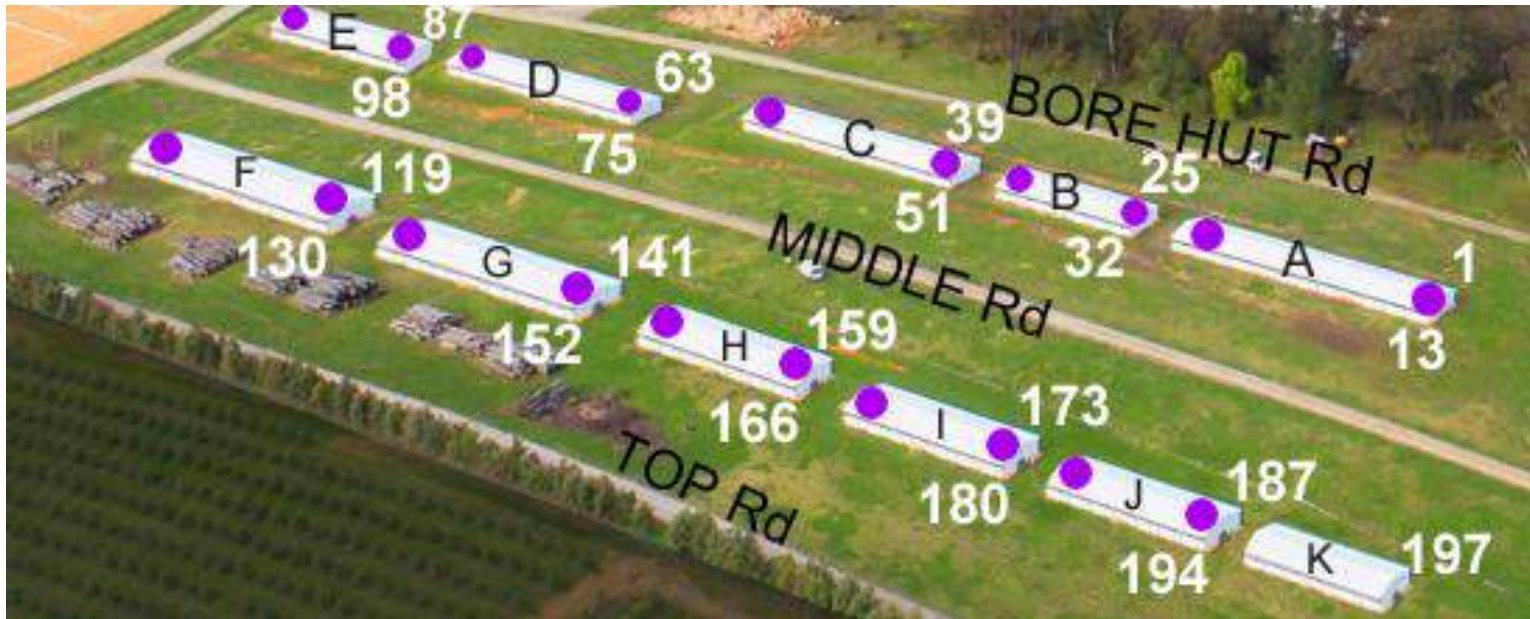
